## LAGREIN

### RISERVA

Südtirol · Alto Adige DOC

Lagrein, one of the most typical red wine varieties of Alto Adige and the Bolzano Winery, thrives on the valley floor around Bolzano with its pronounced diurnal temperature variations. The very old vines produce a wine of above-average quality, with concentrated but velvety tannins, juicy fruit and a powerful body.

<b>Grape variety</b>	Lagrein
<b>Area of cultivation/ climate</b>	More than 80-year-old vines growing on warm sandy alluvial soils in Gries near Bolzano at 250 meters a.s.l.
<b>Grape harvest</b>	End of September to middle of October
<b>Vinification</b>	After traditional red wine fermentation in wooden vats, the young wine matures for about a year in French barriques.
<b>Tasting notes</b>	<p><b>Color:</b> impenetrable garnet</p> <p><b>Aroma:</b> fruity aromas of ripe cherry with floral notes of roses and violets, reminiscent of humus with fine hints of chocolate</p> <p><b>Taste:</b> powerful and harmoniously balanced with a velvety opulence, persistent and elegant</p>
<b>Food pairings</b>	Boiled or grilled dark meats, game and mature cheeses
<b>Serving temperature:</b>	18 °C
<b>Alcohol</b>	14 % vol*
<b>Residual sugar</b>	4,0 g/l*
